



HEALTHCARE LEGISLATIVE BAND-AIDS

AB 2965, expand Medi-Cal to undocumented young adults. *Unlikely to advance.*

AB 3148, increase financial assistance to low/middle-income people. *Died due to cost.*

AB 2565, boost Exchange premium subsidies for low income people. *Unlikely to advance.*

AB 2416, Require insurers with Medi-Cal contracts to join Exchange. *Unlikely to advance.*

AB 2472, Require a study on incl public health ins option on Exchange. *Decision in August.*

AB 2499, Require insurers to spend 80% of premiums on care. *Decision in August.*

AB 2430, increase eligibility for free Medi-Cal. *Unlikely to advance due to cost.*

AB 2459, income tax credit for low income people equal to premiums paid. *Unlikely to advance due to cost.*

AB 2579, Automatic Medi-Cal enrollment of food stamp recipients. *In Appropriations.*

AB 2597, Boost UC funding to increase number of primary care doctors. *Unlikely to advance.*

AB 2718 Expands transitional Medi-Cal to 12 mos instead of 6. *Unlikely to advance.*

AB 2275 Sets quality standards for Medi-Cal managed care plans. *In Appropriations.*

AB 2427 Permit state to better regulate & penalize insurers for anti-competitive practices. *In Appropriations.*

AB 2502, Increase price transparency with database. *\$60 million incl in budget.*

AB 2517, Develop "road map" to "unified" healthcare system (publicly or privately funded). *\$5 million incl in budget.*

AB 3087, Establish commission to set healthcare payment rates. *Held by Author.*
